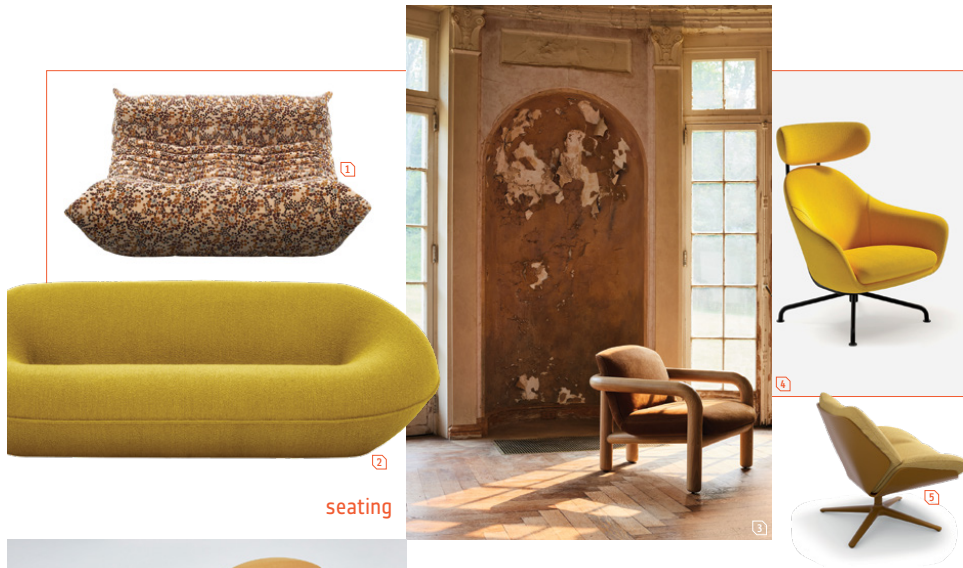

Comfort and efficiency can coexist beautifully. Designed for hard work and major chillaxing, the **Ralik** modular system by Ichiro Iwasaki has got it all covered. The primary module is a single perch with a backrest and an optional attached side table, perfect for laptop work (or sipping Lambrusco). A linking system enables adjoining units into a loveseat, sofa, or longer installation. But it doesn't end there: You can branch out with a two-seater option plus ottoman—as well as benches, a coffee table, and shelving units. Removable covers in leather or fabric (CDM included) amplify the versatility. Bases are polypropylene with recycled content, and tables combine powder-coated metal bases with plywood tops finished with reconstituted oak. arper.com →
